**PUBLIC HUNTING PERMIT AVAILABILITY**

Apply online through <a href="#">COMPASS</a> . Click on “Purchase New License” then “Hunting” and choose the Free Public Hunting Permit. When you complete the checkout process your seasonal permit will print on your hunting license.	After purchasing your hunting license you may obtain the Free Public Hunting Permit from either the Gwynnbrook or Myrtle Grove Office. Have your DNR ID available.	Mail a copy of your hunting license to the Gwynnbrook or Myrtle Grove Office. Please note which areas you are interested in. <b>Include a letter-sized envelope with return address and postage.</b>

**REGULATIONS**

**For all Areas:**

- No building or using permanent tree stands. All tree stands or blinds must be removed at the end of the day.
- Take trash with you. Pick up empty shotgun shells.
- No placing or hunting over bait for any wildlife species.
- No target shooting, camping, building fires, and/or hunting in safety zones or restricted areas.
- Parking on State owned or controlled property is only allowed in designated areas. Do not block gates.
- The cutting of trees, branches, shrubs, or other vegetation is prohibited. This includes cutting shooting lanes.
- Off-road vehicle use is prohibited (except on designated properties with a Universal Disability Pass, call for info).
- Hunters are permitted to have a non-hunting guest accompany them. This person does not need a permit or reservation but must remain with the hunter and unarmed at all times. (C&D Canal Lands require a non-hunting permit, available online)
- Do not walk in or damage agricultural fields until after crops are harvested.
- If entering through a closed and/or locked gate, close and lock the gate behind you when entering and leaving.

**Spring Turkey Specific Regulations:**

- Hunting hours are a half hour before sunrise to sunset for Junior Hunt Days, a half hour before sunrise to noon from April 18-May 9, and a half hour before sunrise to sunset May 10-May 23.
- Only bearded turkeys may be harvested. No more than one bearded turkey may be taken per day. A maximum of two bearded turkeys may be taken per season.
- Turkeys must be tagged and checked in. See your Hunting Guide for property codes and check-in requirements.

**All State, Federal, County, and Property hunting regulations apply.**

Failure to comply with any of these rules or regulations will result in a fine and/or suspension from the program.

**SUNDAY HUNTING**

Sunday hunting will ONLY be allowed on the following **Cecil County and St. Mary's County** Public Hunting Areas in the Central and Southern Regions (other opportunities may exist in other regions, see the Maryland Guide to Hunting and Trapping for details):

**Grove Farm WMA, Old Bohemia WMA, Earleville WMA**  
**Bethel MHA, Courthouse Point MHA, Elk Forest MHA, Welch Point MHA**  
**St. Inigoes State Forest and Salem State Forest**

Sunday hunting is restricted to persons hunting deer, turkey, small game, and furbearers according to state seasons. Migratory birds, including waterfowl, mourning doves, crows, and rails, shall not be hunted on Sundays. See the Maryland Guide to Hunting and Trapping for more information on Sunday hunting.
