ATTENTION ANGLERS

ALL BROOK TROUT CAUGHT MUST BE IMMEDIATELY RELEASED IN THESE WATERS

Proper identification of trout species is necessary to ensure the effectiveness of this regulation.



Brook Trout (must be released) • Red spots with blue halos • Orange fins with white/black edge • Typically less than 14"



Brown Trout • Dark spots, brown/yellow flank • Brown/gold fins
• May reach lengths over 25"



Rainbow Trout/Cutthroat Trout • Small dark spots, silver flank • Red/pink stripe on flank (Rainbow) or lower jaw (Cutthroat)

If you catch a brook trout, please handle the fish

with care and release it quickly.
