REQUEST FOR A PROVISIONAL CHARTERBOAT PERMIT

The Provisional Charterboat permit is not transferable and is valid only to an authorized person operating a vessel for charter fishing trips originating from the tidal waters of Virginia.

To apply you must submit: an application, proof that you were a VA charterboat licensee in 2001 and 2002 and a copy of your current coast guard license and current Virginia charterboat license.
