

## Need help reporting your discarded/released fish?

**Step 1.** After reporting harvest of a species, scroll back up and select "Add New Species".

**Step 2.** Add a second entry of the same species and fill in the required details. Note that a "Discard Reason:" is not required for undersized fish.

**Step 3.** Add a third entry ("Add New Species") if different sizes of fish (Legal and Not Legal) were released.
