### WILDLIFE REGULATIONS SPECIAL PERMIT – DISABLED PERSONS

- A. A person who possess a valid hunting license and who has a disability which impairs their mobility may receive a permit from the Wildlife Division to hunt from a vehicle. However, the person may not shoot or have a loaded weapon in the vehicle while the vehicle is on a public roadway or on the shoulder of a public roadway.
- B. To be issued a **Permit To Hunt From A Vehicle**, a person shall:
1. Submit a completed Wildlife Division application to the appropriate Regional Wildlife manager.
  2. Obtain a physician's signature on the application which certifies that the applicant is mobility impaired.
- C. Each permittee shall:
1. Have the permit on his person while hunting.
  2. Keep the vehicle at a complete stop with the engine off while aiming, or shooting the weapon.
  3. Have all weapons unloaded, including no ammunition in the magazine, while the vehicle is in motion.
- D. A permittee may have other permittees and a companion in the permittee's vehicle while hunting. A hunter may serve as a companion but may not hunt from the vehicle.
- E. In addition to any other sanction provided by law, the Department of Natural Resources may suspend or revoke the permit if the permittee violates any provision of this regulation.



### GARRETT FOREST

(Designated road, length, and location)

- 1. PINEY MOUNTAIN - .3 MILE**  
1.75 mile from Sang Run Rd/Piney Mtn Rd intersection.
- 2. MAPLE GLADE - .1 MILE**  
1.3 mile from Cransville Rd/Maple Glade Rd intersection.
- 3. HERRINGTON CREEK - .15 MILE**  
1 mile south of Swallow Falls Rd/Cransville Rd intersection.
- 4. KINDNESS DEMONSTRATION AREA - 1.45 MILE**  
.6 mile from Rt 39/Fingerboard Rd intersection.

### POTOMAC FOREST

(Designated road, length, and location)

- 5. EAGLE ROCK - .25 MILE**  
.3 mile from Boiling Springs/Eagle Rock Rd intersection.
- 6. LOOP ROAD - .25 MILE**  
1.75 mile from White Church Steyer Mine Rd/Audley Riley Rd intersection.
- 7. BACKBONE MOUNTAIN - 1.20 MILE**  
1.7 mile east from Walnut Bottom Rd/Rt 135 intersection.
