

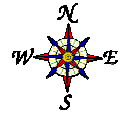

## TREASURE ISLAND



*Complete at least one of the following activities before visiting the Nature Center to get your Passport stamped!*

### Cycle Tour Scavenger Hunt



Explore up to 8 miles of bike trails (gravel, packed sand, and grass) while following a map of the 300-acre South Cell of Hart-Miller Island. Search for clues on informational signs. Watch for nesting and fishing ospreys. Identify water birds in the pond. Don't run over the Fowler's toads!



### Self-Guided Beach Walk



Stroll along the 3,000-foot beach,

- Observing plant succession
- Identifying animal tracks
- Seining for fish and grass shrimp
- Watching birds flying above
- Possibly catching a glimpse of a fox!



### Discovery Hike with a Ranger



Join a ranger on a guided hike along the perimeter road and/or through the forest to the marshy overlook, to see which flowers are blooming, trees fruiting, insects feeding, turtles laying, or birds nesting.
