While walking your pet, be aware of some native plants you may encounter such as Prickly Pear Cactus and Sandburs which can injure your pet's feet if stuck in the pads.

## take it slow & steady

Pets must be on a hand-held leash that is no longer than 6 feet and must be well-behaved at all times.

## cool down

You should avoid leaving pets in a parked car or non air-conditioned enclosed camping unit even if the windows are open. It takes only minutes for a pet left in a vehicle on a warm day to succumb to heatstroke and suffocation.
