

**RACCOON HUNTING RULES**  
**FAIR HILL NATURAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT AREA**  
**2016 – 2017**

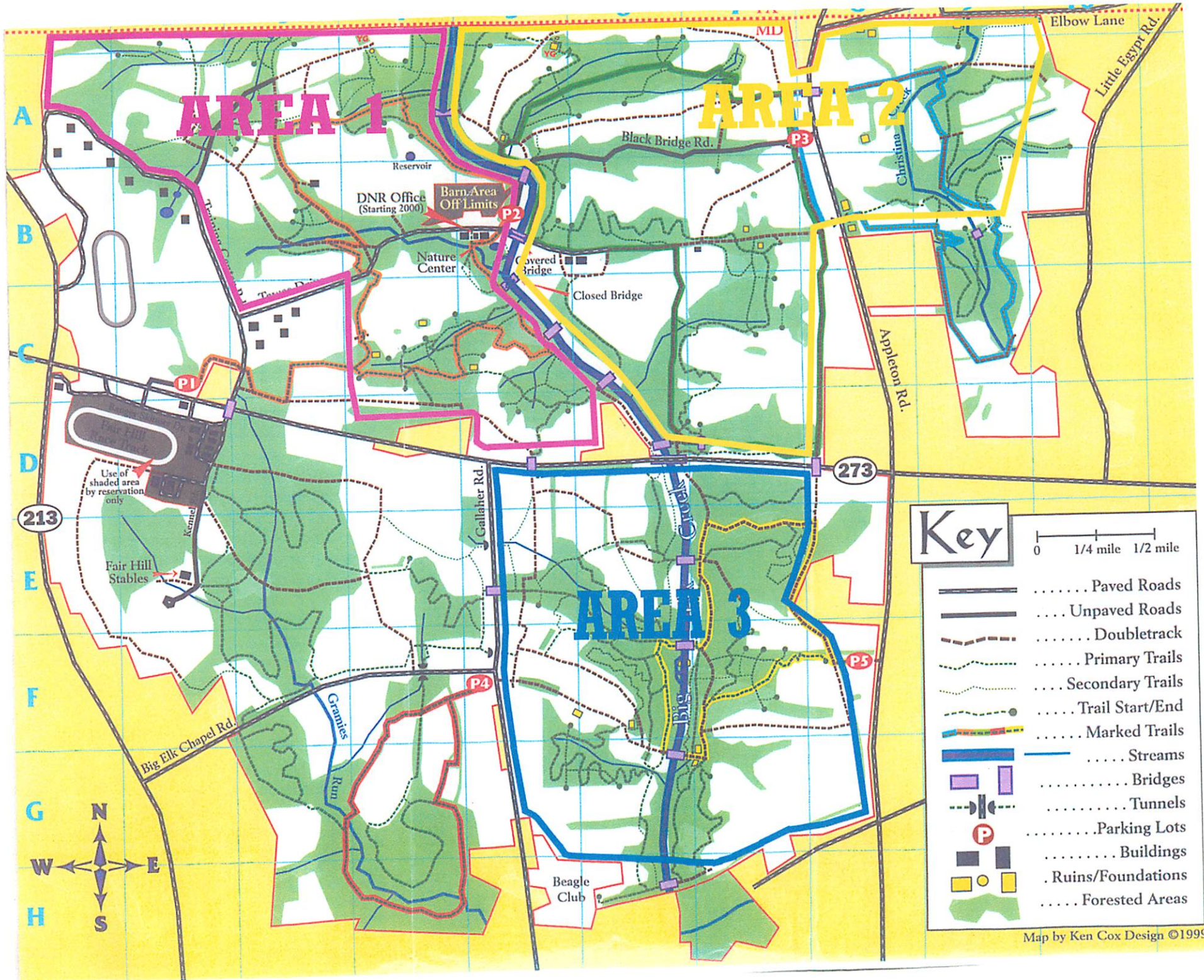
1. All applicable State and Federal Hunting Regulations will be followed and strictly enforced.
2. All Raccoon Hunters are required to purchase and carry a Furbearer Permit, a Managed Hunt Permit, as well as, a regular Maryland Hunting License.
3. The Condominium Association Area (Training Center) is off limits (see attached map).
4. Raccoon Hunting hours are Sunset to 2400 hours (midnight), Wednesday and Saturday nights only. Hunters and dogs are to be back at their vehicles by 2400 hours.
5. Hunting areas may be altered, closed or shifted without prior notice if deemed necessary by DNR personnel.
6. Hunting will consist of Areas 1, 2 and 3 only.
7. It is the responsibility of each permit holder to familiarize themselves with the designated hunting areas by examining the map located at the Fair Hill DNR office.
8. To obtain a Fair Hill Raccoon Hunting Permit, each individual must have a valid Hunting License or be exempt from license in accordance with Maryland Law.
9. A Fair Hill Raccoon Hunting Permit is not valid unless a reservation is made not more than eight days in advance and not later than the night prior to the Raccoon Hunting. To assist the department in managing the raccoon population, raccoons taken must be reported to the Fair Hill office the day following the hunt.
10. All dogs must be inoculated for rabies.
11. Killing or taking of any animal other than raccoons during Raccoon Hunting is prohibited.
12. A parking permit will be issued by the Fair Hill DNR office and must be visibly displayed on the vehicle dash. Parking is authorized only in designated areas (see attached map).
13. The maximum number of personnel and dogs on each Raccoon Hunt or party will be three and five respectively. Raccoon Hunting without raccoon chasing hounds is prohibited.

**14. The 2016 - 2017 Raccoon Hunting season and dates inclusively at Fair Hill are:**

**October 15, 2016 – March 15, 2017**

- 15. Each hunting party may possess one 22 Caliber Rim Fire Rifle (22 Magnum excluded). All other firearms or weapons, such as a hunting bow, in a vehicle or in possession during a Raccoon Hunt is prohibited.**
- 16. Raccoon Hunting Field Trials dates have not yet been announced. The permit fee will be \$25.00 per group per weekend hunt. Permit will be issued only after receiving a copy of the Wildlife Division's Field Trial Permit.**
