Rangers and naturalists lead children and teens, ages 7- 12 years, through the fundamentals of environmental education and stewardship.

Junior Rangers can earn three achievement awards: Basic, Advanced, and Expert.

Once they complete their Expert Achievement award, they begin to earn patches in our more self-guided levels, such as Naturalist, Explorer, Conservationist, and Guide.

Upon completion of this summer's program, Junior Rangers will receive a Membership card and 'Basic' level patch. They will then qualify to progress to the next level!
