



Savage River State Forest Handicapped Hunter Access Roads



Savage River State Forest will open two gated roads to provide vehicular access for handicapped hunters. Two roads totaling 2.86 miles are currently located on the forest.


Handicapped hunter roads will be recognized by a "Vehicle Access by Special Permit Only" sign at the road entrance. Mobility impaired hunters only, with a "Permit Display Card" on the vehicle and a valid permit in their possession will be allowed to drive on these roads. Other hunters may hunt in the area but will not be allowed to drive on the designated roads.

All hunting laws and regulations that apply to state and county roads must be adhered to on state forest roads also. More information on designated roads and hunting regulations are available at:
