2020 REGULATION CHANGE REQUESTS — DECISIONS

ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY

Magothy River — Southern Shore Area

The request was to relocate the demarcation line for the 6 knot speed zone that is in place at all times during the year approximately 400 feet north (downstream) of the Cool Springs Cove/Fork Creek waterway area, near the vicinity of Ulmstead Estates Community Marina – Dock #2. **DECISION: CHANGE REGULATION**

Mill Creek Proper (Northern Branch) and Martins Cove

The request was to remove both the Mill Creek Proper (Northern Branch) and Martin Cove speed zone demarcation lines and establish a new demarcation line in the main stem of Mill Creek that will begin just prior to the intersection fork of the current regulations waterways. The requested speed limit was 6 knots on Saturdays, Sundays, and State holidays at all times during the year. **DECISION: CHANGE REGULATION**

Severn River

The request was to establish a 6 knot speed limit that would be in place at all times during the year. The request was for a 220-yard zone for the main grounds of the Naval Academy that would extend approximately 20 yards west of U.S. Aids to Navigation – Green Can #13 to the third western column from the center of the Naval Academy Bridge. **DECISION: NO CHANGE TO REGULATION**

South River — Riva Bridge

The request was to change the Riva Bridge speed zone from 6 knots on Saturdays, Sundays, and State holidays during the boating season (April 15 – October 15) to 6 knots at all times during the year. This would make the speed zone in the area the same as the zone near the Route 2 Bridge. **DECISION: CHANGE REGULATION**

GARRETT COUNTY

Deep Creek Lake — North Glade Cove

The request was to approve the modification of the existing speed zone in North Glade Cove. Part of the zone was requested for removal and part of the zone was requested to be changed to a minimum wake zone at all times of the year. This matter was previously processed by the Deep Creek Lake – Policy and Review Board.

DECISION: CHANGE REGULATION

TALBOT COUNTY

Harris Creek — Eastern Branch

The request was to establish a 6 knot speed zone that would be in place at all times during the year in upper Harris Creek – Eastern Branch, east of Cummings Creek.

DECISION: NO CHANGE TO REGULATION

Tred Avon River

The request was to establish a 6 knot speed zone that would be in place at all times during the year for the area beginning at the entrance/intersection into Jacks Creek, continuing upriver and ending in the vicinity of Talbot County's – Easton Point Landing and Boat Ramp near U.S. Aids to Navigation – Daybeacon Red #22.

DECISION: NO CHANGE TO REGULATION
