The Secretary of Natural Resources proposes to amend Regulation .02 under COMAR 08.04.16 Special Uses Areas.

Statement of Purpose

The purpose of this action is to update the list of registered vessels that may request a DNR Ski Sticker. The current regulation includes a list of qualified vessels, and permits the Department to issue a DNR Ski Sticker to owners of a registered qualified vessel. The Department is updating its list of qualified vessels with the Approved Tournament Towboats list approved and developed by USA Water Ski & Wake Sports. USA Water Ski & Wake Sports is the national governing body of organized water skiing and wakeboarding in the United States. USA Water Ski & Wake Sports is also a member of the International Waterski & Wakeboard Federation (world governing body). The USA Water Ski and Wake Sport's towboat approval process includes performing a series of 11 tests and sub-tests which include power and acceleration and centerline deviation. Additionally, the USA Water Ski and Wake Sport Approved Tournament Towboats list is updated annually. Thus, the Department is proposing to update its list of qualified vessels to mirror this governing body's list.

The Maryland Board of Certified Public Accountants proposes to amend Regulation **.03** under **COMAR 09.24.05** Examinations.

Statement of Purpose

The purpose of this action is to make Maryland's educational requirements comparable to neighboring jurisdictions. Surrounding states have a lower threshold, and there are concerns that applicants may be choosing other states in lieu of testing in Maryland. This action would change some of the educational requirements to be a CPA in Maryland. This action was considered uncontroversial.

.03 Educational Requirements.

A. To take the Uniform CPA Examination, an applicant shall satisfactorily complete:

(1) Unless otherwise indicated, a minimum of 27 undergraduate semester hours [or 40.5 undergraduate quarter hours] of accounting education to include each of the following subjects:

(a) Auditing of at least 3 undergraduate semester hours [or 4.5 undergraduate quarter hours];

(b) Financial accounting of at least 9 undergraduate semester hours [or 13.5 undergraduate quarter hours];

(c) [Managerial cost accounting] *Accounting information systems* of at least 3 undergraduate semester hours [or 4.5 undergraduate quarter hours]; and

(d) U.S. federal income tax of at least 3 undergraduate semester hours [or 4.5 undergraduate quarter hours]; and

(2) At least 3 undergraduate semester hours [or 4.5 undergraduate quarter hours] in:

(a) Business ethics; or

(b) Accounting ethics[;].

[(c) Philosophy of ethics; or

(d) A course that examines the framework for modern ethical decision making.]

B. In order to become licensed, in addition to satisfactorily completing the requirements set forth in §A of this regulation, an applicant shall satisfactorily complete *3 undergraduate semester hours in business law and* a minimum of [21] *18* undergraduate semester hours [or 31.5 undergraduate quarter hours] in the following business-related subjects, including 3 undergraduate semester hours [or 4.5 undergraduate quarter hours] in at least five of the following subjects:

(5) [U.S. business law] Data analytics;

(6)—(7) (text unchanged)

(8) Information technology/systems; [and]

(9) Quantitative methods[.]; or

(10) Other business-related content areas included in the Uniform CPA Examination Blueprints.
