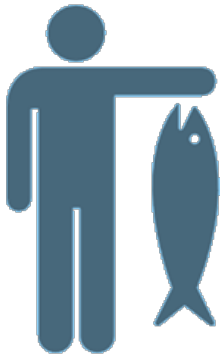


2019 STRIPED BASS VOLUNTEER ANGLER SURVEY

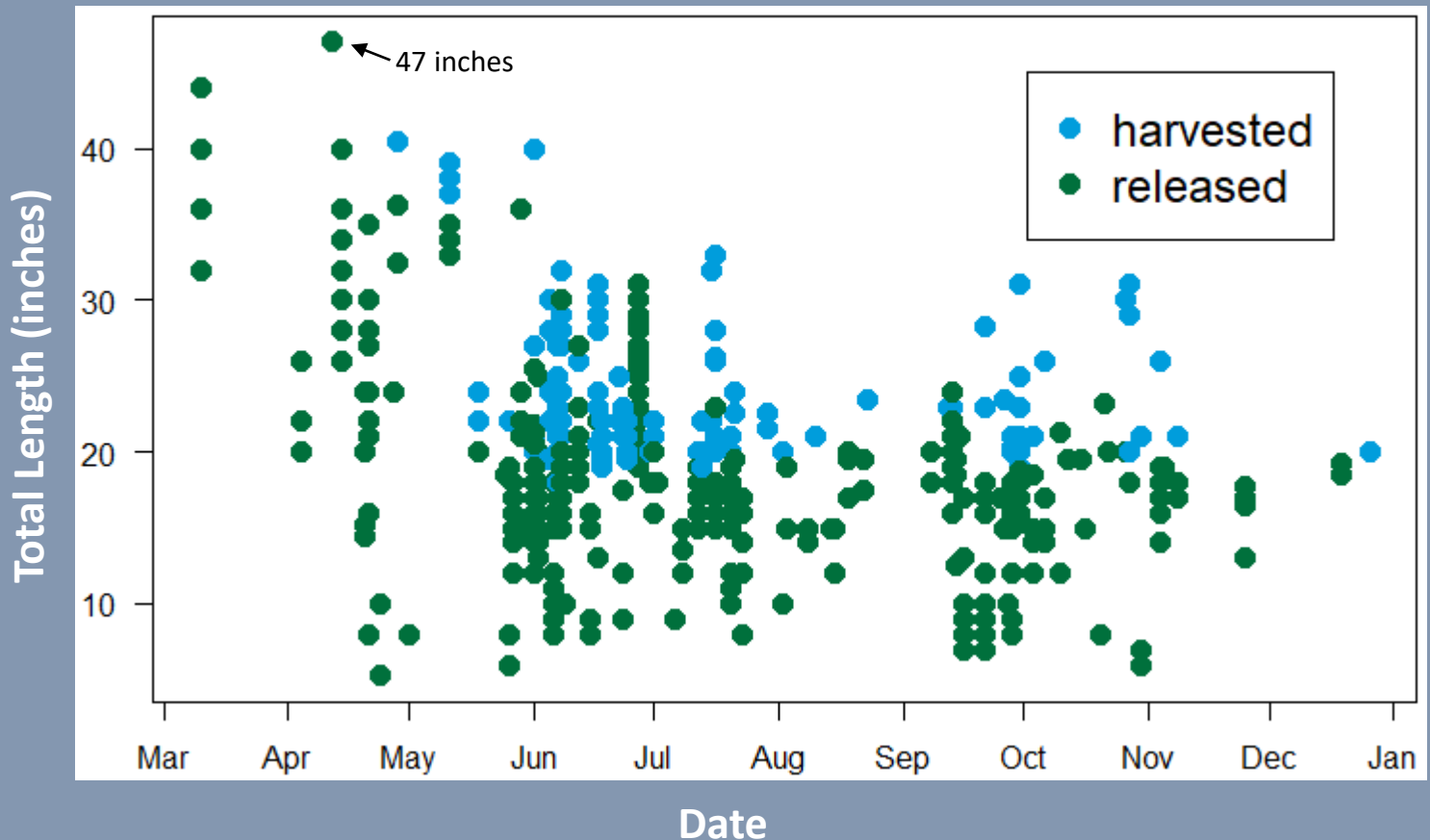


In 2019, anglers reported data from **106** striped bass trips through the Volunteer Angler Survey. **Thank you** for your continued participation!

The Volunteer Angler Survey can now be accessed through the **AccessDNR** mobile app, available for both iPhone and Android devices.



Lengths of striped bass reported in 2019



477 striped bass lengths were reported in 2019:

- **28%** were **harvested** (average length **23.5** inches)
- **72%** were **released** (average length **17.8** inches)

Volunteer angler survey data helps fisheries scientists to characterize the sizes of striped bass harvested or released by recreational anglers in Maryland throughout each year.
