Why use FACTS?

- When you use FACTS, you send timely trip data to fishery biologists to help them responsibly manage fisheries
- FACTS accounts feature customized business tools for viewing and managing your harvest history
- 24-hour Helpline support available

How does it work?

- Start your trip before you leave the dock
- Send your harvest information before you land
- Report only on the days you're guiding
- Access FACTS with your smartphone or speak with a 24-hour operator to report your trips in real-time
