The Secretary of Maryland Department of Natural Resources (DNR), pursuant to Natural Resources Article, §4-11A-09(g), Annotated Code of Maryland, is giving notice of an application for a shellfish aquaculture submerged land lease by Angela L. Abey and William E. Abey in the Choptank River, Dorchester County, Maryland, within the Upper Choptank Oyster Sanctuary. The proposed lease area, located approximately 1,100' east of green channel marker "33" and 2,100' southwest of Goose Creek, contains 12.1 acres more or less and is enclosed by a line beginning at corner 1, at or near Lat. 38° 35' 41.5" N., Long. 75° 58' 55.5" W., then running 281° 25' (True), approximately 214 meters to corner 2, at or near Lat. 38° 35' 42.9" N., Long. 75° 59' 4.2" W., then running 29° 47' (True), approximately 355 meters to corner 3, at or near Lat. 38° 35' 52.9" N., Long. 75° 58' 56.9" W., then running 142° 24' (True), approximately 136 meters to corner 4, at or near Lat. 38° 35' 49.4" N., Long. 75° 58' 53.5" W., then running 191° 11' (True), approximately 247 meters to the point of beginning.

The applicants propose to deposit oyster shell and spat-on-shell as needed within the given area to a maximum depth of two inches for the purpose of culturing Eastern Oyster (*Crassostrea virginica*), and to harvest using methods approved by the Department. Lease corners will be marked in accordance with Code of Maryland Regulations. The Department will hold a public informational meeting upon written request from a member of the public. In addition, any person who has a specific right, duty, privilege, or interest that is different from that held by the general public and may be adversely affected by the proposed lease may file a Petition of Protest with the Department. Petitions that meet the requirements of Natural Resources Article §4-11A-09(g) shall be forwarded to the Office of Administrative Hearings for adjudication.
