APPLICATION FOR SHELLFISH AQUACULTURE LEASE – DERRICK A. GAMBRILL &
LEAH B. GAMBRILL

The Secretary of Maryland Department of Natural Resources (DNR), pursuant to Natural Resources Article, §4-11A-09(g), Annotated Code of Maryland, is giving notice of an application for a shellfish aquaculture submerged land lease by Derrick A. Gambrill and Leah B. Gambrill in the Wicomico River, Wicomico County, Maryland, located approximately 750 feet northwest of channel marker "15". The area applied for contains 91.6 acres more or less and is enclosed by a line beginning at corner 1, at or near Lat. 38° 14' 17.9" N., Long. 75° 51' 57.7" W., then running 336° 31' (True), approximately 209 meters to corner 2, at or near Lat. 38° 14' 24.1" N., Long. 75° 52' 1.3" W., then running 305° 43' (True), approximately 319 meters to corner 3, at or near Lat. 38° 14' 30.0" N., Long. 75° 52' 12.1" W., then running 57° 41' (True), approximately 790 meters to corner 4, at or near Lat. 38° 14' 44.1" N., Long. 75° 51' 44.9" W., then running 136° 31' (True), approximately 81 meters to corner 5, at or near Lat. 38° 14' 42.2" N., Long. 75° 51' 42.6" W., then running 148° 54' (True), approximately 320 meters to corner 6, at or near Lat. 38° 14' 33.4" N., Long. 75° 51' 35.6" W., then running 154° 39' (True), approximately 121 meters to corner 7, at or near Lat. 38° 14' 29.9" N., Long. 75° 51' 33.4" W., then running 238° 5' (True), approximately 697 meters to the point of beginning.

The applicants propose to deposit oyster shell as needed within the given area to a maximum depth of two inches for the purpose of culturing Eastern Oyster (*Crassostrea virginica*), and to harvest using methods approved by the Department. A map of the proposed lease is attached.


The Department will hold a public informational meeting upon written request from a member of the public. In addition, any person who has a specific right, duty, privilege, or interest that is different from that held by the general public and may be adversely affected by the proposed lease may file a Petition of Protest with the Department. Petitions that meet the requirements of Natural Resources Article §4-11A-09(g) shall be forwarded to the Office of Administrative Hearings for adjudication. Comments, written requests for public informational meetings, and/or Petitions of Protest must be received by the Department of Natural Resources Aquaculture and Industry Enhancement Division 580 Taylor Avenue E-4 Annapolis, MD 21401 by March 30, 2018.
