APPLICATION FOR SHELLFISH AQUACULTURE LEASE – PJH OYSTER LEASES, LLC &
PHILIP J. HARRINGTON, III

The Secretary of Maryland Department of Natural Resources (DNR), pursuant to Natural Resources Article, §4-11A-09(g), Annotated Code of Maryland, is giving notice of an application for a shellfish aquaculture submerged land lease by PJH Oyster Leases, LLC and Philip J. Harrington, III in Monie Bay, Somerset County, Maryland, located approximately 1,600 feet east northeast of channel marker "10". The area applied for contains 28.4 acres more or less and is enclosed by a line beginning at corner 1, at or near Lat. 38° 13' 14.2" N., Long. 75° 51' 54.8" W., then running 326° 5' (True), approximately 321 meters to corner 2, at or near Lat. 38° 13' 22.9" N., Long. 75° 52' 2.2" W., then running 56° 17' (True), approximately 179 meters to corner 3, at or near Lat. 38° 13' 26.1" N., Long. 75° 51' 56.1" W., then running 161° 54' (True), approximately 133 meters to corner 4, at or near Lat. 38° 13' 22.0" N., Long. 75° 51' 54.3" W., then running 66° 18' (True), approximately 207 meters to corner 5, at or near Lat. 38° 13' 24.7" N., Long. 75° 51' 46.5" W., then running 337° 30' (True), approximately 164 meters to corner 6, at or near Lat. 38° 13' 29.6" N., Long. 75° 51' 49.2" W., then running 48° 23' (True), approximately 23 meters to corner 7, at or near Lat. 38° 13' 30.1" N., Long. 75° 51' 48.5" W., then running 122° 14' (True), approximately 324 meters to corner 8, at or near Lat. 38° 13' 24.5" N., Long. 75° 51' 37.2" W., then running 234° 36' (True), approximately 534 meters to the point of beginning.

The applicants propose to deposit oyster shell as needed within the given area to a maximum depth of three inches for the purpose of culturing Eastern Oyster (*Crassostrea virginica*), and to harvest using methods approved by the Department. A map of the proposed lease is awcej gf 0


The Department will hold a public informational meeting upon written request from a member of the public. In addition, any person who has a specific right, duty, privilege, or interest that is different from that held by the general public and may be adversely affected by the proposed lease may file a Petition of Protest with the Department. Petitions that meet the requirements of Natural Resources Article §4-11A-09(g) shall be forwarded to the Office of Administrative Hearings for adjudication. Comments, written requests for public informational meetings, and/or Petitions of Protest must be received by the Department of Natural Resources Aquaculture and Industry Enhancement Division 580 Taylor Avenue E-4 Annapolis, MD 21401 by April 6, 2018.
