## Public Notice Maryland Department of Natural Resources Fishing and Boating Services Application for Shellfish Aquaculture Lease – Timothy M. Robinson and Susan M. Robinson

The Secretary of Maryland Department of Natural Resources (DNR), pursuant to Natural Resources Article, §4-11A-09(g), Annotated Code of Maryland, is giving notice of an application for two shellfish aquaculture submerged land lease areas by Timothy M. Robinson and Susan M. Robinson in Fishing Bay, Dorchester County, Maryland, located northwest of the mouth of Elliott Creek. These areas have been proposed by the applicants as expansions of their existing submerged land lease, DO 715. The area applied for, which is adjacent to and on the north side of their existing lease, contains 14.0 acres more or less and is enclosed by a line beginning at corner 1, at or near Lat. 38° 18' 59.2" N., Long. 76° 0' 7" W., then running 337° 38' (True), approximately 104 meters to corner 2, at or near Lat. 38° 19' 2.3" N., Long. 76° 0' 8.7" W., then running 66° 55' (True), approximately 278 meters to corner 3, at or near Lat. 38° 19' 6" N., Long. 75° 59' 58.2" W., then running 129° 53' (True), approximately 294 meters to corner 4, at or near Lat. 38° 19' 0" N., Long. 75° 59' 48.8" W., then running 269° 54' (True), approximately 160 meters to corner 5, at or near Lat. 38° 18' 59.9" N., Long. 75° 59' 55.4" W., then running 266° 37' (True), approximately 282 meters to the point of beginning.


The area applied for, which is adjacent to and on the south side of their existing lease, contains 5.1 acres more or less and is enclosed by a line beginning at corner 1, at or near Lat. 38° 18' 51.4" N., Long. 76° 0' 3.2" W., then running 61° 34' (True), approximately 276 meters to corner 2, at or near Lat. 38° 18' 55.8" N., Long. 75° 59' 53.3" W., then running 83° 19' (True), approximately 158 meters to corner 3, at or near Lat. 38° 18' 56.4" N., Long. 75° 59' 46.8" W., then running 168° 17' (True), approximately 59 meters to corner 4, at or near Lat. 38° 18' 54.5" N., Long. 75° 59' 46.3" W., then running 257° 33' (True), approximately 178 meters to corner 5, at or near Lat. 38° 18' 53.2" N., Long. 75° 59' 53.5" W., then running 351° 19' (True), approximately 31 meters to corner 6, at or near Lat. 38° 18' 54.2" N., Long. 75° 59' 53.7" W., then running 266° 19' (True), approximately 27 meters to corner 7, at or near Lat. 38° 18' 54.1" N., Long. 75° 59' 54.8" W., then running 168° 44' (True), approximately 35 meters to corner 8, at or near Lat. 38° 18' 53.0" N., Long. 75° 59' 54.5" W., then running 257° 56' (True), approximately 217 meters to the point of beginning.

The applicants propose to deposit oyster shell and spat-on-shell as needed within each of the given areas to a maximum depth of three inches for the purpose of culturing Eastern Oyster (*Crassostrea virginica*), and to harvest using methods approved by the Department. The Department will hold a public informational meeting upon written request from a member of the public. In addition, any person who has a specific right, duty, privilege, or interest that is different from that held by the general public and may be adversely affected by one or both of the proposed lease areas may file a Petition of Protest with the Department. Petitions that meet the requirements of Natural Resources Article §4-11A-09(g) shall be forwarded to the Office of Administrative Hearings for adjudication. 
