


# 2018 STRIPED BASS VOLUNTEER ANGLER SURVEY

The Volunteer Angler Survey can now be accessed through the **AccessDNR** mobile app, available for both iPhone and Android devices.




Every volunteer angler is eligible for a prize drawing!

## 618 striped bass

lengths were reported in 2018:

**34%** were **harvested**

**66%** were **released**



Did you know? Volunteer angler data is one of the few sources of information about lengths of striped bass that are caught and **released** in the recreational fishery in Maryland.

## Average size of striped bass reported:

	Trophy Season (3 <sup>rd</sup> Saturday in April – May 15 <sup>th</sup> )	Summer/Fall Season (May 15 <sup>th</sup> – December 15 <sup>th</sup> )
Harvested	<b>37.3</b> inches	<b>23.7</b> inches
Released	<b>25.2</b> inches	<b>17.3</b> inches
