
INVASIVE CATFISH IN THE CHESAPEAKE BAY WATERSHED

- The department asks anglers to keep any blue and flathead catfish they catch.
- Catch and release of these fish is discouraged, as they are invasive top predators and pose a serious long-term threat to our native species.

IN MARYLAND, IT IS ILLEGAL TO TRANSPORT LIVE BLUE AND FLATHEAD CATFISH INTO ANOTHER BODY OF WATER.

VIOLATORS CAN BE FINED UP TO \$2,500.
