(1) Amendments to Regulations .01, .02, and .04 under COMAR 10.46.01 General Regulations; and

(2) Amendments to Regulation .04, new Regulation .05, amendments to and the recodification of existing Regulation .05 to be Regulation .06, and the recodification of existing Regulations .06—08 to be Regulations .07—09 under COMAR 10.46.06 Competency Requirements for Physical Agent Modalities.

This action, which was proposed for adoption in 42:13 Md. R. 807—810 (June 26, 2015), has been adopted with the nonsubstantive changes shown below.

Attorney General's Certification

In accordance with State Government Article, §10-113, Annotated Code of Maryland, the Attorney General certifies that the following changes do not differ substantively from the proposed text. The nature of the changes and the basis for this conclusion are as follows:

COMAR 10.46.01.02D, E(2), F(2), and H: The current definition of the term "verification" as defined in COMAR 10.46.01.02B(29), makes the point of what was intended by the term "primary source"; therefore, the deletion of "primary source" is nonsubstantive, as it eliminates a contextual redundancy.

COMAR 10.46.01.02G(2): Deletion of "term" eliminates surplus language and, as such, is non-substantive.
