## MENU OF ACTIONS

The **Schoolyard Forest Program** – a Five Million Trees partnership initiative with the Maryland Association of Environmental & Outdoor Education – is being offered to public schools across the state to promote healthier campus landscapes where students of all backgrounds can have access to the benefits of nature.

Through this initiative, the State of Maryland will develop partnerships with municipalities, schools, and students to leverage the critical role of **schoolyards as community centers** to provide incentives to increase tree canopy cover, create pathways for the discovery of nature, and support local climate resiliency priorities.
