  - Green Ridge State Forest- Allegany County April 5<sup>th</sup> at 10am
  - Cedarville State Forest Prince George's County April 7<sup>th</sup> at 10am

If you wish to be included in one of these outlying deliveries, please place your order with 48 hours of date. \*\*Deliveries will be made at 10am\*\*

After your order is processed, you will receive a Sales Order - Please bring it with you when you pick up your order. Be sure to count your trees & shrubs at American Native Plants BEFORE you leave the grounds. (Shortages discovered later will NOT be replaced.)

This is <u>NOT</u> a program for planting on private property. All trees must be planted on public land including, but not limited to; parks, community open spaces, rights-of-ways, government facilities, and school grounds.
