Dear Forest Products Operator:

Enclosed is your application for a calendar year 2020 Maryland Forest Product Operators (FPO) license in accordance with Natural Resources Article 5, Section 608, Annotated Code of Maryland. A FPO license is required for any business engaged in sale of forest products, which includes lumber, piling, logs, pulpwood, firewood, bark, chips, shavings, and sawdust.

Please be sure to check the box at the top of the application indicating whether yours is a renewal or new application. The fee remains unchanged at \$20 for the calendar year.

Please remember to report the estimated volume of forest products you harvested or sold in 2019. (This obviously does not apply to new applicants.) Applications without this information shall be rejected and returned to sender.
