Old Business

Review of Minutes:

Approval of the August meeting minutes was completed. Brad moved a motion to approve and Juls seconded the motion. The vote to approve passed.

Volunteer Hours (Since last meeting): 41 hours total Brad – 12, Bernie – 11, Champ – 8, Juls – 10

Financial Activities:

Bernie provided a copy of the updated financial report. He stated that the checkbook and the bank statement matched. A check for \$13.50 was written to the DNR for mulch for the fall tree planting grant. Several donations were received and deposited for the PLT and the Liberty Tree program. **FOR 101 Camp:**

Juls provided a recap of how the inaugural Forestry camp went at Evergreen Heritage Center this summer. They started with 11 total students and 9 completed the camp. Students were given a forestry knowledge test prior to and after camp and there was significant improvement! Juls also mentioned that there would be a Real-World Forestry training coming soon for college kids, which is to be sponsored by DNR. He will keep the group posted on info.

Smokey's Reading Challenge:

Smokey's reading challenge was not executed this summer, partially due to lack of participation by Rocky Gap State Park who had agreed to partner for the event. This can be an idea for the future.

Fall Urban Grant:

Adam updated the group that 3 trees and 3 bags of mulch were purchased and planted at Pleasant Valley Regional Office. These trees replaced trees that had previously died. Also advised that there would likely be more grants in the spring pass through the board.

NRCC:

Marie said that new brochures and advertising will be done prior to next years camp. Again, 2024 camp was a success and Adam shared the thank-you letters from the 4 Allegany County students.

Liberty Tree:

Champ stated that he would be collecting seed for future liberty trees at St. John's College within the next couple of weeks. He will be working with Davey Tree Care to get a bucket truck to access the seed.

New Business:

Mike Minnick Donation:

The group was able to donate \$130 total out of pocket to be donated to a scholarship in memory of Mike. The idea was mentioned to match the \$130 to send to Hospice Care of Garrett County, which was also a charity near and dear to Mike. Champ made the motion to support both causes and Brad seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

Big Tree Program:

The idea was mentioned to host a big tree measuring day / field day for the board. In general, the group was in favor, however we realized that the weather would be turning sooner rather than later so the idea was tabled until next spring. However, some members would still like to measure trees on their own time. Adam will send group current nomination forms, as well as a permission form to be completed by the landowner. Adam will also create a list of big trees to be measured in the future.

PLT:

Fall PLT Workshop will be held on October 25th at FSU. Several members of the DNR were invited as special guests, including Secretary Kurtz. All sponsors were also invited to attend. No word back from the Cacapon institute on attendance. They were previously interested in joining the workshop. Bernie made a motion for the board to pay for the PLT facilitators/guests' lunch at the workshop and Juls seconded it. The vote passed unanimously.

5th Grade poster contest:

The group discussed some options which will better reach students across the county. There was also some discussion on establishing drop off locations for poster collections. It was suggested to just use each school as a collection point. Sarah suggested that we create a short video or flyer promoting the contest in order to increase interest.

High/Middle School Art Poster Contest:

The board has been discussing the idea of creating a poster contest for high and middle schoolers with monetary prizes. There was a brief discussion on creating a flyer/video to hand out to science and art teachers across the county. Also, some discussion on partnering with Allegany Arts Council or the Ferleman Art Gallery on sponsoring prizes. No firm decisions were made, and it was tabled til the next meeting.

Website/Facebook:

Adam reminded the board to send a headshot and brief biography to post on the website. And also reminded them to provide information related to programs to post on the website (Champ- Liberty Tree, Bernie- PLT). Marie plans to have a work-study student work on the website this fall.

Brad was in contact with someone in the library system about creating a new logo to be placed on our historical tree cookie at the LaVale library. He presented a couple of different options and board members were in favor of using them.
