# Old Business

#### **Review of Minutes:**

Approval of the October meeting minutes were completed. Champ made a motion to approve and Juls seconded the motion. The vote to approve passed.

**Volunteer Hours (Since last meeting): 41 hours total** Brad -6, Bernie -24, Champ -24, Juls -2, Steve -8 and Sarah -8 Total = 72

A fillable form will be available starting in 2025 to track volunteer hours.

#### **Financial Activities:**

Bernie provided a copy of the updated financial report. He stated that the checkbook and the bank statement matched. A check for \$49.37 was written to Champ to cover the cost of shipping Liberty Tree seed to the state nursery. Several donations were received and deposited for the PLT and the Liberty Tree program.

### Mike Minnick Donation:

The board was able to donate \$130 total out of pocket to be donated to a scholarship in memory of Mike. A check for \$130 was written out to Hospice Care of Garrett County in memory of Mike Minnick as well.

#### PLT:

The Fall PLT Workshop was held on October 25<sup>th</sup> at FSU. 20 students attended the workshop from both Frostburg State (elementary ed major) and Allegany College of Maryland (forest technology). Various board members and DNR staff were present to assist with the workshop. Also, a director's commendation was presented to the board for 32 years of facilitating these workshops, completing a total of 88 workshops, which have reached a total of approximately 2,600 students so far.

## **Liberty Tree:**

Champ stated that he was able to successfully complete two rounds of seed collection from the Liberty Tree at St. Johns College. He partnered with Davey Tree Care company to use a bucket truck with a lift in order to reach seed higher up on the tree. The seed was then sent to the state nursery to be germinated. Champ suggested the idea of grafting the tree in order to provide seedlings with the direct DNA from the last remaining Liberty Tree in our country.

### **Historical Tree Cookie:**

Brad and Champ updated the group that the historical tree cookie project is complete and is officially on display at the LaVale library. This cookie was dedicated on arbor day 2024 and now permanently resides in a hand-made display case with a historical write-up panel which was built by Brad Metzger. The cookie is from a 356-year-old white oak which grew right beside the national highway.

# Statewide meeting recap:

No one from the board attended the meeting. Some were not invited, and others were not able to login to the virtual meeting. The virtual meeting invite was sent out well after the meeting was scheduled to start. The board expressed some frustrations with the process of the statewide meeting.

### **New Business:**

### **Big Tree Program:**

The board tentatively plans to have a big tree measuring field day in the spring of 2025 around May. The idea to host a public event and educate landowners about forestry and big trees was suggested for early fall 2025 around September. Adam sent out nomination forms and information pertaining to the rules of the statewide program. Adam will also create a list of big trees to be measured in the future. Marie will have an ACM work study student compile a list of current big trees in Allegany to be inventoried.

# 5<sup>th</sup> Grade poster contest:

The board decided to have our poster contest information ready to send out by mid-January. All posters are to be turned in by February 7<sup>th</sup> and will be voted on by the board in the February meeting. Marie will put together an information packet and Sarah will work on a short power point presentation. Winning posters could be on display at a local art gallery and paired with a seedling give-away event. We are still awaiting details on the upcoming poster contest in 2025.

## **High/Middle School Art Poster Contest:**

The board has been discussing the idea of creating a poster contest for both highschool and middle schoolers with monetary prizes. There was a brief discussion on creating a flyer/video to hand out to science and art teachers across the county. Also, some discussion on partnering with Allegany Arts Council or the Ferleman Art Gallery on sponsoring prizes. No firm decisions were made, and it was tabled til the next meeting.

#### Website/Facebook:

Marie reminded the board to send a headshot and brief biography to post on the website. And also reminded them to provide information related to programs to post on the website (Champ- Liberty Tree, Bernie- PLT). Marie plans to have an ACM work-study student work on the website this fall.

### **New enrollment:**

Deb Landau attended our meeting for the first time on behalf of TNC. She said she will likely be back for future meetings and consider her application in early 2025. Also, Slater Hafer plans to attend future meetings and consider putting his application in for early 2025 as well.
