The board website will need a new administrator and our current hosting service is changing the servers to Microsoft 365, which requires an annual subscription to use. The Board is considering using services from the MAFCB to migrate our content to a new website and hosting service. The board is also considering the need to continue having a website, since traffic volume has decreased significantly.
- Sierra Club planting The Sierra Club will be planting trees at the Solomons Town Park on 10/14/22 provided through a MUCFC grant approved by the Board.
- Forestry Board membership The meeting was attended by Amalia Pleake-Tamm, the new Environmental Planner for Calvert P&Z. Amalia is a Calvert Co. native and is interested in learning more about the Board. At this time she does not wish to apply for board membership, but may be interested in the future.
