Treasurer's Report

• Current balance - \$3,595.00

Old Business

- Website update – A first draft of the website has been constructed. The Board reviewed the site and several suggestions for changes and corrections have been made. Steve will work with the web designer to implement the changes. A December launch date is targeted.
- ADPC – the Board discussed the new prizes that will be offered at this year's Arbor Day Poster Contest. The prizes will be sourced from National Symbols Cache and will result in a ~\$200 savings compared to the current vendor, Woodland Catalog.

New Business

- Ag Preservation Advisory Board (APAB) presentation Jen David and Tommy Briscoe • gave a presentation on Calvert Co.'s preservation efforts. Per state law, the APAB and Forestry Boards are required to meet annually to see where the two boards can coordinate their activities. The Forestry Board will attend an APAB meeting in early 2025 to continue coordination between the boards.
- Grant application The Board discussed increasing their annual grant request to the • county from \$3,100.00 to \$3,400.00, but decided to keep the budget request flat at the request of the county govt.
- Big Trees The Board has approximately 15 trees to remeasure by the end of the year. • The Board will start remeasuring soon.
