Treasurer's Report

Old Business

- Big Tree Program 18 trees in Calvert require remeasurement in 2025. Jill has mailed • out permission forms to all privately owned trees. Anyone who doesn't respond to the second notice will be removed from the list. The Board also voted (6-0) to remove non-native trees with less than 150 points from the list.
