• Ag Preservation Program update – The Board received a presentation from Jennifer David, staff planner to the county Ag Preservation Advisory Board (APAB). The APAB is updating the county Ag Preservation program in anticipation of opening the program back up after a moratorium was placed in 2013. The update aims to consolidate all previous Ag Preservation agreements, update policy to be consistent with the current zoning laws and streamline the program. Forested properties can and have qualified for participation in the program.
