Minutes of the Garrett County Forest Conservancy District Board Meeting June 3, 2024

Call To Order:

The Garrett County Forestry Board met at 9:00 a.m. on Monday June 3, 2024 at the Mountain Fresh Pavilion. Those Board members in attendance either in person or virtually were: Mike Minnick, Mike Kozier, Bill Buckel, Will Williams, John Bambacus, Fred Eggleston, Siera Wigfield and Melissa Nash. Also in attendance was Molly Ramsey, Watershed Coordinator and scholarship recipients Zobiana Dillsworth and Isabel Knapp.

The agenda was approved with motion by Fred and 2nd by John.

Scholarships of \$500 each were presented to Zobiana and Isabel.

Molly was introduced as the new Garrett County Watershed Coordinator.

Minutes of the previous meeting were approved following a motion by Fred and 2nd by Will.

Bill B. read the treasurer's report. We refunded leftover MUCFC funds to the MD Forestry Foundation, paid our booth fee for the fair, and sent in NRCC fees for 3 students.

OLD BUSINESS:

Watershed

This was Molly's first day on the job. Her background is a bachelors degree in biology and a masters degree in environmental science. She has previously worked on a stream ecology project at Mill Run and has worked with communities to understand their experience with flood events.

Arrowhead cove SAV plantings are complete.

Siera has received an ARC trails planning grant to find a Oakland to Herrington Manor route as well as an Oakland to Rt 135 route. John asked how much the existing trails are advertised. Discussion included Garrett Trails website, maps available on park/state forest websites and in offices, Deep Creek Lake Adventure Bureau, use of apps like AllTrails and guided events by parks. Further discussion included possibly holding a fall foliage hike or tree scavenger hunt. The group agreed it was difficult to find centralized information on trails.

Siera has also applied for some trail money for an intermediate bike trail at Fork Run. She should hear if that has been funded by the fall.

NRCC

We have a 4th applicant and Melissa will work with Mike K and Will to set up an interview. Will reported the camp is having trouble finding night staff again.

Mt. Loggers

The group will meet June 11th. The golf tournament is June 15th. There will be a WVU Forestry day camp July 15-19. Cost is \$120/student. Anyone wanting to join Mt. Loggers, dues are being collected. Cost is \$20/year.

Forestry Board Summit

Bill B. will present any comments from the board.

Concerns already listed include

- -complete lack of legislative updates in 2024
- -lack of timber market in Maryland's western region and the tri-state area as a whole. There has been much talk of woody biomass but little action or market development
 - -other market possibilities such as cardboard production were suggested
 - -Swallow Falls bridge project is still a concern with regard to old growth hemlock
- -there is an overall lack of information being sent out & those who are unable to attend meetings do not get any follow up information

NEW BUSINESS:

TACF will complete maintenance on the Pea Patch orchard June 18th. They have planted additional trees there since our initial planting in 2019. We may start seeing female flowers soon.
