

Licensed Tree Expert Information

Continuing Education Credits

..... **only Calendar Year 2021 only**

In response to the Governor's Executive Orders [Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Outbreak], the Maryland Forest Service (MFS) will accept the following online courses to meet the MD Licensed Tree Experts continuing education requirement (8 ceus) for those renewing Dec 2021 and Dec 2022 (both odd and even numbered licenses). For those LTEs that are ISA certified arborists, ISA online courses can be submitted but you must submit the course description and proof of completion in order for the MFS to determine if the course is eligible and the number of credits if eligible.

To use: *One form can be used for multiple courses.*

Initial the course taken, sign and date the form and send by mail, fax or email to the Maryland Forest Service by Dec 31, 2021 - for both odd and even numbered licenses. ***There may be a delay after clicking start.***
