On behalf of the Allegany County Commissioners, I am sending the Fiscal Year 2026 Program Open Space Annual Plan for development and acquisition projects.

The County's POS allocation is being directed to Allegany College of Maryland, Town of Barton, Cresaptown Civic Improvement Association, City of Frostburg, Potomac Valley Athletic Association, Flintstone Community Park, Bishop Walsh School, and Allegany County for the development of the Willowbrook Outdoor Wellness Center. Also included in the plan are Glendening Park Renovations and Gene Mason Park Upgrades. Both projects were included in the FY25 Annual Plan, but the individual applications were not submitted.

These projects address the goals of Allegany County's 2022 Land Preservation, Parks and Recreation Plan, which was adopted by the County Commissioners on September 8, 2022.








