1. Meeting called to order at 1:02pm by John Turgeon.

- 2. Approval of Minutes from June 3rd & August 9th Mr. Lloyd motioned for the approval of the committee minutes. Mr. Burnett seconded the motion. All voted in favor.
- 3. Overview/discussion of the Board Agenda and for the Guests Speakers at the September 9th, 2024 Board meeting.

Mr. Turgeon stated that a new Easement Program Manager Daniel Skalos has been hired and will start work on October 2nd, 2024. Mr. Skalos will be moving from California and has easement experience through his work in California with a similar Agency to our DNR Wildlife & Heritage Service.

5. Finance Committee Update

Mr. Hoffman stated that the Finance Committee had a guest speaker during the last Finance Committee meeting. The speaker was a representative from the Southern Maryland Conservation Alliance, who requested a donation of \$5,000 to help finance a conservation outreach and advocacy project. The Finance Committee is in support of this donation and details will be brought to the full MET Board at a later date for a vote.
