Sarah joined Scenic Rivers in 2015 and became the Executive Director in 2019. Sarah led Scenic Rivers Land Trust through the national accreditation process, which it was awarded in August 2019 by the Land Trust Alliances' Land Trust Accreditation Commission. In 2022, Sarah worked to reassign and accept five existing conservation easements totaling 224 acres, from the Pasadena-based North County Land Trust (NCLT). Before accepting the NCLT easements, Scenic Rivers held 71 conservation easements across the county, totaling more than 3,200 acres.
