What is needed in order to develop more environmentally literate young citizens in Maryland? To answer this ongoing question, participants will break into small discussion groups to look at needs and opportunities for action items for the Partnership in 2015. Resulting ideas will be used by the Steering Committee to develop the 2015 CIN Action Plan.

Groups will be organized by topics as below, and each participant will work with two different topics. A list of highlights of CIN work done in these areas to date will be provided. Groups will brainstorm what is missing and what still needs to happen, then generate ideas for action items that the Partnership could do this year. Participants will be asked to consider and offer suggestions on **resources** and potential **opportunities** (including what they might be able to contribute directly) and **new partners** or stakeholders to bring to the table.

- <u>Means</u> Do we have the means in place in all areas necessary to be successful? This group will discuss the "who and how" to engage (examples: reaching diverse audiences, preparing teachers, engaging parents/families, broadening partnerships, etc.).
- <u>Content</u> "What" are some content areas we need to address in ways that we are not currently (such as climate change, big picture conservation issues, increased outdoor experiences, health considerations)?
- <u>Access</u> Is nature accessible for all schools and communities? What are some areas that need attention to be sure all children have the "where," i.e., green spaces available and easily accessed, transportation to natural areas, programming in parks and interest among families, and more.
