From the Governor of the State of Maryland

ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION MONTH

APRIL 2021

WHEREAS, Environmental education includes the interdisciplinary understanding of local, state, regional, national and global environmental issues, including air, water and soil quality, human and environmental health and justice, biodiversity, habitat protection and restoration, land use, energy, sustainable development; and climate change; involving a wide variety of academic disciplines, including all sciences, mathematics, social studies, civics, economics, language arts, and more; and

WHEREAS, Maryland has risen as a leader regionally and nationally in embracing environmental education as an integral part of providing a world class education and preparing our students with the necessary understanding and skills to participate responsibly in environmental decision-making, to live sustainably, and to build an environmentally literate statewide community and workforce that cares for our waters, parks and lands; and

WHEREAS, Environmental education provides teachers with a creative extension of their classroom and real world learning through meaningful student-driven action in Maryland's communities, creating an appreciation for our cultural heritage, values and natural resources; and

WHEREAS, Exploration and enjoyment of the outdoors - both as part of a formal education program as well as an unstructured, recreational activity - is critical to nurturing children's curiosity, developing a sense of stewardship for nature, and improving children's health; and Maryland is working to intentionally connect more children to nature in their local communities; and


WHEREAS, Maryland is committed to providing equitable opportunities for persons, who are reflective of the state's diversity, striving to empower all residents to be environmental stewards and to promote the inclusion of everyone in creating a resilient future in the face of climate change; and

WHEREAS, 2021 is the 51st anniversary of the first Earth Day, which occurs annually in April, and in recognition and celebration of the great strides that have occurred in advancing environmental education for all Marylanders to ultimately benefit our Earth.
