

Questions on PPRP RFP

1. Please explain the difference between “Contingency Transmission Line Licensing” and “General Transmission Line Technical Support” for Functional Area B (see p. 89 of the RFP). There seems to be a fair amount of overlap between the two activities.

Response: As indicated in the descriptions, "contingency transmission line licensing" refers to work that supports specific CPCN cases. "General transmission line technical support" is broader and is not linked to specific CPCN cases, and includes tasks like "conduct forward-looking research projects" and "refine and expand ...databases".

2. For the Long-Term Electricity Report (Functional Area D), the RFP states the report will be published in December 2021 (see p. 97). On p. 98, the RFP states: “the contractor shall build insufficient resources into its proposal to accommodate questions and/or presentations to the Governor’s Office and General Assembly from the issuance of the final report until the last day of the 2020 General Session.” Since the LTER is not scheduled to be released until December 2021, does DNR/PPRP mean to say “the last day of the 2022 General Session?”

Response: That is correct, thank you for pointing out this error.
