General Hunting Regulations Cypress Branch State Park



Cypress Branch State Park offers approximately 75 acres of woodlands designated for archery deer hunting. All hunters must strictly adhere to state and federal game laws in addition to Maryland Park Service regulations. **Trapping, Sunday hunting, and nighttime hunting are prohibited.** Vehicles are not permitted within the confines of the park's designated hunting areas and parking is restricted to designated lots marked on the map.

Site-Specific Rules & Requirements

- Sign-In Required: All hunters must sign in before entering the hunting area and sign out upon leaving. The sign-in bulletin board is located at the Hunter Parking Lot.
- A total of **SIX (6)** bow hunters are permitted each day – THREE (3) in the morning and THREE (3) in the afternoon - on a first-come, first-served basis
- Safety Zones: No hunting within 150 yards of any dwelling, public road, or adjacent property line.
- Tree Stands: Temporary stands only; must be removed at the end of each day.

Species & Season Closure:

- No Firearms Season
- White-tailed Deer Hunting Only
