MAY 6: BIRDING AND TECHNOLOGY

Search for birds in the park. Learn about documenting bird sightings with others online with sources like eBird, Neststory, and Merlin. Binoculars are available to borrow.

MAY 13: HISTORIC TOUR

Meet with a descendant of Fannie Mae Saulter the last Lighthouse keeper of Turkey Point. With a tour inside the Lighthouse discover its history.

MAY 20: YOGA

Calm your body and your mind as we flow through a gentle yoga practice. Wear loose clothing and bring a mat if you have one.

JUNE 3: CANOE/ KAYAK TRIP

Spend the morning with rangers on a guided paddle out of Rogues Harbor along the Elk River. Equipment and PFD's provided and no paddling experience required.

JUNE 10: TREE PLANTING

Roll up your sleeves and help plant some trees. Learn about the importance of stormwater management along the Chesapeake Bay. Gloves available to borrow.

JUNE 17: STATEWIDE GATHERING
