Parking Lot #5 (2000 Appleton Road) - Also known as the South Appleton Parking Lot. From the Rt.
 273/Rt. 213 intersection: Drive east on Rt. 273 until the intersection with Appleton Road. Turn right on Appleton Road; drive approximately one half mile. Parking lot is located on the right side of the road.
