

## PROJECT FACTS

### 1. Project Limits:

- Fair Hill Natural Resources Management Area.
- Project area is bordered by Telegraph Road (State Route 273) to the north, Singerly Road (State Route 213) to the west, Big Elk Chapel Road to the south, and Gallaher Road to the east.

### 2. Project Purpose:

- Improve equestrian facilities for the community
- Upgrade equestrian facilities to accommodate USEF/FEI 5-Star event in October 2020

### 3. Proposed Improvements

- Reconstruct equestrian oval track & timber course
- Construct new equestrian arenas
- Construct park trails, drives, parking, and utilities
- Construct combined stormwater management and irrigation pond
- Widen and extend existing horse trail for cross-country events and non-equine groups
- Extend an existing culvert carrying an unnamed tributary to Gramies Run
- Restore Gramies Run channel and floodplain
- Improve storm drain structure (culvert) carrying Gramies Run under Big Elk Chapel Road

### 4. Construction Schedule (Estimated)

- Begin construction Spring 2019
- Construction substantially completed late 2019
