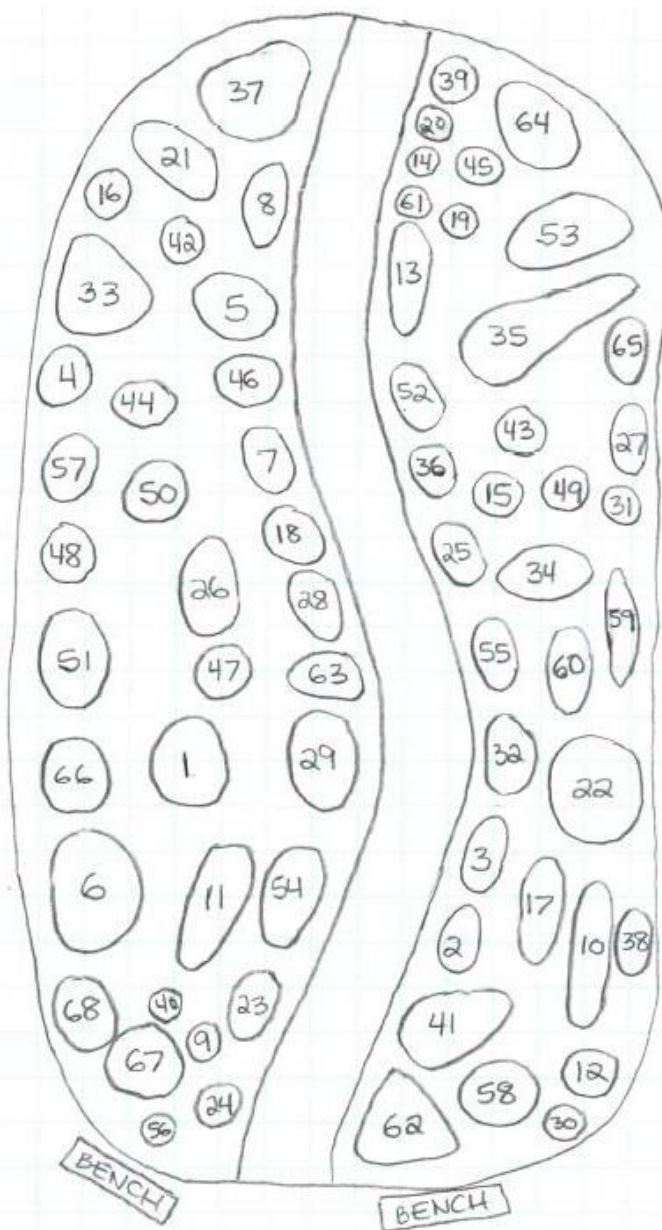


NATIVE PLANT GARDEN MAP

*WETLAND INDICATOR STATUS:		
OBL	Obligate Wetland	Almost always occur in wetlands.
FACW	Facultative Wetland	Usually occur in wetlands, but may occur in non-wetlands.
FAC	Facultative	Occur in wetlands and non-wetlands.
FACU	Facultative Upland	Usually occur in non-wetlands, but may occur in wetlands.
UPL	Obligate Upland	Almost never occur in wetlands.
NI	Not Indicated	Not indicated.
