**Creature Corner: Reptiles!** - Meet and learn about Cedarville's scaly animal ambassadors. At Park HQ.

**Nocturnal Neighbors Campfire** - Learn about bats, owls, and more while roasting marshmallows. Bring a flashlight/headlamp and a camp chair. At the Amphitheater. Weather Permitting.

**B.A.R.K. Ranger Hike** - Bring your dog on a guided hike of the 3.5-mile White Trail to get them B.A.R.K. Ranger Certified. Meet at the Charcoal Kiln. Weather permitting.

**White Trail Guided Hike** - Enjoy the changing leaves with a leisurely guided hike of the 3.5-mile White Trail.
