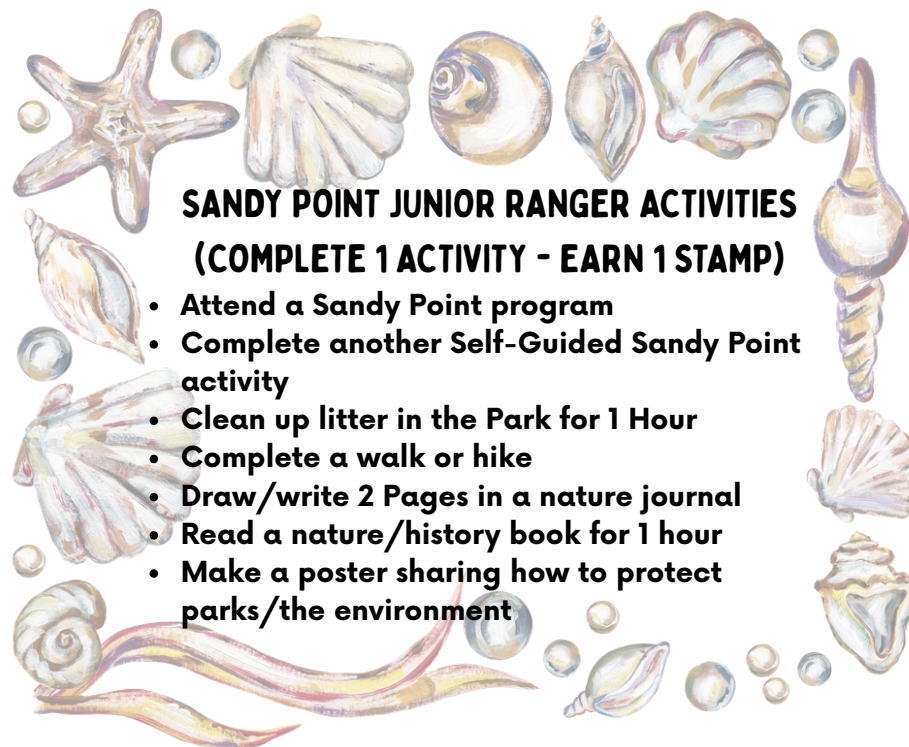
A Sandy Point Junior Ranger protects the park by **helping people who visit** and **respecting the plants and animals that live here**. In other words, they are a **park steward**!
