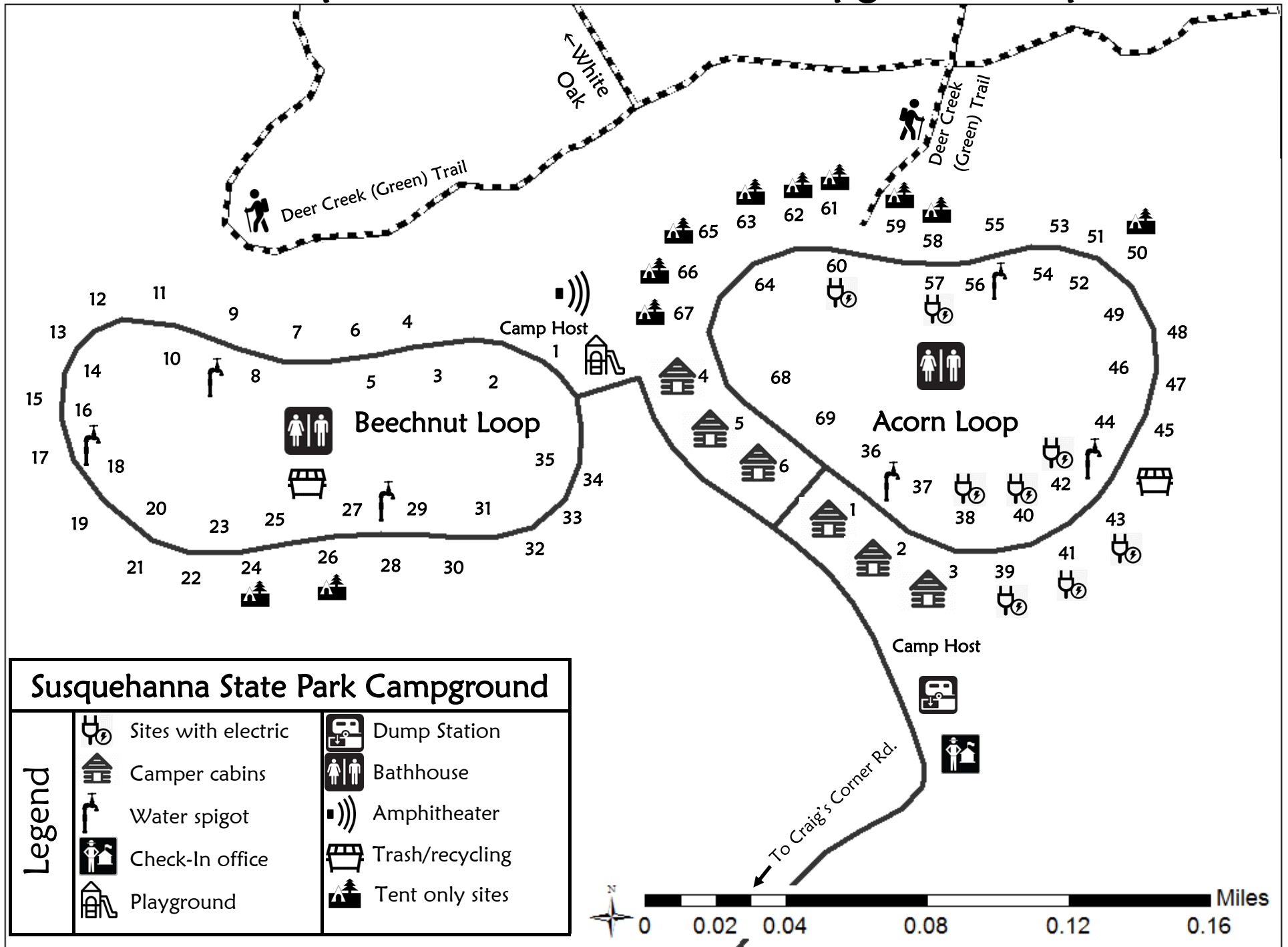


# Susquehanna State Park - Campground Map

## Campground Rules:

- **Campsite check-out time:** 1 p.m. for campsites, 12 p.m. for cabins.
- **Quiet hours:** 10 p.m. - 7 a.m. All visitors to campers must leave by 10 p.m. Generators must be turned off at 10 p.m.
- **Total campers per site:** 6 people maximum overnight for campsites, 4 people maximum overnight for camper cabins.
- **Vehicles:** 2 vehicles per site (a boat counts as a vehicle). To minimize environmental impact, please keep vehicles parked in the gravel driveways provided.
- **Camping units:** 2 sleeping units at each site. All camping units must be placed on the camp pad (when available).
- **Fires in fire-rings only:** Please keep all firewood inside of the ring. Do not burn plastic, metal, trash, or other materials.
- **Pets must be kept on a leash at all times.** Please, no pets inside of bathrooms.
- All playgrounds and hiking trails close at sunset.
- **Prohibited:** Alcohol, fireworks, weapons, water balloons, and power tools. Please do not cut, damage, or nail into trees (live or dead).

## Park Features

**Trails:** Susquehanna State Park offers over 15 miles of trails ideal for hikers, bikers, equestrians, and nature lovers. See the Park Trail Map for more information.

**Rock Run Historic Area:** This area features the Rock Run mill, an operational 200 year old gristmill, the historic Carter-Archer mansion, and the Jersey Tollhouse.

**Boating:** The Lapidum boat facility offers direct access to the Susquehanna River and the headwaters of the Chesapeake Bay. Parking or launch fees required.

**Fishing:** Fishing is popular in Deer Creek and the Susquehanna River. Fishing licenses are required for anyone over the age of 16.

**Picnicking:** The Deer Creek Picnic Area is open daily and features picnic tables, grills, restrooms, and a large playground. There are also two large picnic pavilions available for rent.
