

# 2024-2025 BOW HUNTING AT BRIDGETOWN PONDS NATURAL HERITAGE AREA

The Bridgetown Ponds Natural Heritage Area (NHA) consists of 134 acres, 100 of which are available for bow hunting of white-tailed deer. Due to the limited acreage and the close proximity of residential areas, bow and arrow are the only weapons permitted.

The acreage available for hunting is clearly marked. Environmentally Sensitive Areas are located to the west of the road and marked with white "NO HUNTING, WEAPONS PROHIBITED" signs.

**FIVE (5) bow hunters are permitted each day from November 30, 2024 through January 31, 2025.** Hunters must sign-in AND out at the sign-in box outside the shop complex at Tuckahoe State Park. ***Hunting is prohibited on Sundays.***

DIRECTIONS FROM THE TUCKAHOE STATE PARK SHOP COMPLEX: Exit the driveway and turn right. Turn left onto Cherry Lane and go approximately seven (7) miles to the intersection with MD Rt. 312. Cross onto East Cherry Lane and go approximately 150 yards. The Bridgetown Ponds Area is on your left and marked by a sign and a brown steel gate. Parking is limited to the roadside only. Do not block gate.
