## **Tuckahoe Orienteering Course**

This course is tough and travels through rough brush, mud and briars. Be prepared before you go with long pants, bug spray and time to find the points. The pins are short 4X4 posts approximately one foot tall painted red and white. Other clues noted below may be helpful if you know the Park!

Each Pin has a letter which must be recorded in order as they are found.

Begin at the four way intersection near Disc Golf goal #5.

- 1) 50 degrees for 725 feet
- 2) 359 degrees for 299 feet (\*\*\*Time for Tee?)
- 3) 331 degrees for 680 feet (\*\*\*Bicentennial Rock)
- 4) 357 degrees for 700 feet
- 5) 66 degrees for 833 feet (\*\*\*Passing a Man's Corner)
- 6) 82 degrees for 608 feet
- 7) 127 degrees for 408 feet
- 8) 192 degrees for 493 feet (Looking Tall)
- 9) 266 degrees for 546 feet (Just a Swingin')
- 10) 197 degrees for 406 feet
- 11) 174 degrees for 268 feet
- 12) 252 degrees for 873 feet (Tee again?)
- 13) 201 degrees for 832 feet

Each Marker has a letter which you need to record. Unscramble the letters for a course break determined by the group leader.
