Wolf Den Run State Park Rules

Hours (motorized use): 9 a.m. to 6pm (April 1 – October 31)

9 a.m. to 4pm (November 1- March 31) Closed to Motorized use, Tuesday & Wednesday
* No motorized use allowed during the deer firearms season, (two weeks, beginning the first
Saturday after Thanksgiving). The park remains open for walk-in hunting and non-motorized use.

Hours (non-motorized used): Sunrise to Sunset.

User Rules:

- All ORV's, off-road vehicles, must be out of the park by designated closing time. Non-motorized users can park at gravel lot in between entrance gates daily from Sunrise and Sunset.
- All users must possess a valid reservation to operate an off road vehicle at Wolf Den Run and be able to provide proof of the reservation via phone or paper copy. To obtain a reservation prior to riding please visit Herrington Manor State Park, the Wolf Den Run State Park Website, or call (301-334-9180)
- ❖ All users must have a valid driver's license, learner's permit, etc...
- ❖ All users under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
- All users must possess a DNR-ORV registration while operating an off road vehicle or must be registered with the Department of Motor Vehicles and the vehicle registration must be properly displayed.
- All vehicles must be operated in a safe manner to avoid collisions or accidents. Ride all trails with caution and obey posted speed limits on roads.
- Park vehicles and load and unload in designated areas only (gravel parking areas).
- Stay on designated trails at all times and always expect oncoming traffic. Wolf Den Run is a multi-use park so expect other visitors such as hikers and mountain bikers along with other ORV riders.
- Camping is only permitted with a permit at the Wolf Den Run State Park Campground.
- ORV users are recommended to travel in groups of two or more ORV's and carry a cell phone for emergencies, note some areas have limited cell service.

ATV, Dirt Bike, Side by Side, and UTV Safety:

- All users must wear a DOT approved helmet at all times the vehicle is in operation please note: this includes loading and unloading of vehicles.
- Protective eyewear must be worn at times the vehicle is in operation. (e.g. goggles, face shield, glasses, windscreen, etc.)
- No user may exceed the vehicle manufacturer's recommended passenger limit.
- ❖ It is also highly recommended all users wear the additional riding gear gloves, chest protector, long pants, long sleeve shirt, and closed toe shoes.
- Vehicles must be equipped with an approved spark arrestor.

Full Sized Vehicle Safety:

- Vehicles must have proper roll-over protection to include passengers.
- Seat belts must be worn by all users when the vehicle is in operation.
- The vehicle must have a fire extinguisher and a trash bag for liquid spills.
- A winch and locker are recommended equipment, especially for challenging trails.

Prohibited Activities:

- No alcoholic beverages,
- No firearms or weapons, except during designated hunting season.
- No open fires, except in the Wolf Den Run Campground or Potomac Picnic Area.
- No dumping or littering.
- No feeding or harassing wildlife.
- No damaging or moving any natural objects or materials (e.g. trees, plants, rock, etc...) updated 7.14.2021
