

*The Map & Compass Part I & Part II and Chainsaw Skills Part I & Part II are single two-part classes that requires you to take both the Saturday morning and Saturday afternoon classes (no exceptions).

<u>Confirmation</u>: Once your registration is received, a confirmation letter with a listing of the classes in which you have been enrolled, a list of what to bring, health and consent forms and directions will be **emailed** to you.

Lodging: Western Maryland 4-H center is located in Garrett County near the town of Bittinger. The accommodations are in rustic cabins (no heat/AC), where lodging is dormitory style on steel frame beds with mattresses. Evenings can be quite cool, so plan accordingly. You must bring your own pillow, sheets or sleeping bag, towels and toiletries. Showers and toilets are in nearby separate buildings.

<u>Meals/Special Needs</u>: Meals are cafeteria style served at designated times. If you have any dietary restrictions or needs that require special arrangements, please notify the registrar by phone at 301-491-8150 or by email at <u>letha.grimes@maryland.gov</u>. **Please indicate on top of your registration form.**

<u>Photographs</u>: Participants understand that photographs may be taken during the sessions and may be used to promote Maryland Department of Natural Resources programs.

<u>Cancellation Policy</u>: Cancellations on or prior to close of business (COB) (5pm) on July 10 will receive a full refund. Cancellations after COB on July 10 until COB July 17 will receive a full refund minus a \$25 processing fee. Cancellations after COB on July 17 until COB on July 24 will receive a 50% refund. Any cancellations after COB on July 24 are not eligible for a refund. Registrants who do not attend and who do not cancel prior to the workshop are not eligible for a refund. You may send a substitute by notifying the registrar at 301-491-8150 no later than July 24. The substitute **must** take the classes you choose. **Returned checks** will be assessed a \$25 service fee.

Scholarships: Scholarships are available. Recipients are required to pay \$75.00. Please send a letter stating your need, along with the registration form and a check for \$75.00, to the registrar. Deadline for scholarship requests is July 3. You will be notified of the panel's decision by July 10.
